New Dismissal Process- starting January 11, 2021

Bus Students: Bus students will be dismissed from their class in groups at 2:55 pm and make their way to the bus. This process takes about 10 minutes. Buses will leave the parking lot at approximately 3:05 pm. Bus drivers feel this will not make a significant difference in their drop off schedule. As always, their timing depends on how many riders are on, road conditions, traffic etc. They will let you know directly if it will affect your child's drop off time more than 10 minutes.



Picked Up Students: Students who are picked up will be dismissed at the 3:05 pm dismissal bell. Pick up time for all students is from 3:05 until 3:30 pm. If you have special pick up times already in place, they stay the same. Parents, please **do not** arrive before 3:05 pm, as this causes congestion in our parking lot. Remember, arriving early doesn't mean you get out of the parking lot first. You can't leave without your child:).


