Report Cards and Parent Teacher Interviews Updates

As we prepare for our first Parent Teacher Interviews coming up in November, we wanted to reach out to you regarding some shifts CESD is making to the ways we report on your child's progress:

- This year, CESD is transitioning to two reporting periods for all K to Grade 12 students. Parents can expect to see 2 report cards K-12: January 27 and June 27.
- We continue to invite parents to participate in **Parent Teacher** Interviews (PTIs) in both the fall and spring. These connection points are an important opportunity for parents to gain a deeper understanding on how their child is progressing both academically and socially emotionally in the classroom.
- Our fall PTIs are on November 23 and 24th. For your convenience we are offering this opportunity in person, over the phone or in a Google Meet. You will be booking your appointments online as we have done for the past two years. Ms. Salomons will be sending you information next week on how to book your appointments.
- Teachers will continue to communicate student progress via phone calls, email, Google Classroom, in person meetings where necessary and communication apps if they choose.

Remembrance Day Ceremony


