- a. Hot Lunch (Stephanie Sommerfeldt): lunches going as planned, one rotation of meals has been completed, thank you to all volunteers involved up to this point.
 November 22 will be the due date for December/January orders
 - i. Christmas Dinner will take place on December 17th. Donations can be made through the hot lunch order page - the amount of Christmas dinners ordered is equivalent to dollar amount for donation. Donation of menu items can also be made. Spiral pre-cooked ham, mashed potatoes, gravy, buns, carrot sticks, pickles, cheese. Donation of time as many volunteers are needed to make the meal happen
- b. Bottle Drop off (Tina Louise): November 5th and 6th. The trailer will be available during the day as well as during parent/teacher interviews in the evening
